

Coaches - Covid-19 rules from the F.A.

Coaches:

- Should ensure that training can take place with 30 or less participants, including coaches.
- A register of attendees should be maintained for all training sessions and matches.
- Safety briefings are required before each match for home and away teams.
- Should communicate that pre-match handshakes are forbidden, as are team huddles, goal celebrations and spitting.
- Are required to maintain a record of regular cleaning of team equipment. *Bibs should not be used until further notice.*
- Should ensure that the hot water boiler in the store cupboard at Bessingby Park is switched on to allow hand washing in warm or hot water. *The boiler should be switched off after use.*
- Should ensure toilets are available with hot water and soap or hand sanitiser available.
- Should re-acquaint themselves with Safeguarding policies and procedures.
- Should limit persistent close proximity of participants during training and matches.
- In the case of player injuries, self-distancing should be observed where possible. If present a member of the player's household should be invited on to the pitch to assist. If treating an injured player, the coach should be wearing a mask. Hand sanitiser should be used as soon after treatment as possible.
- Should be aware that indoor football is currently banned; *so, no Northolt High School sports hall for the time being.*
